#### **Climate Change Action Plans through Environmental Awareness**

#### Introduction

The Sinkunia community in Falaba District is facing environmental challenges because of human activities. These challenges are deforestation, charcoal production, timber logging, bushfires to name but few.

In an effort to effectively protect, sustainably manage the environment and natural resources to ensure a quality of the environment adequate for human health, a team of Youth Movement for Sustainable Development Sierra Leone (YoMSuD-SL) officials have organized a sensitization meeting at the Sinkunia Community Barray Saturday 9 September 2018.

## The Meeting

The meeting started with Muslim and Christian prayers. Mariama B.Sesay did introduction of the YoMSuD-SL staff while the Youth Chairman Mr. Balla S.Kamara introduced stakeholders. In making his statement on behalf of the Organization, Mamoud B.Kamara thanked the people of Sinkunia for attending the environmental sensitization meeting.

He informed the people that the purpose of the meeting is to sensitize and raise awareness on the environmental challenges that are of national and global concern. He made mentioned on the August 14 disaster that took place in Freetown as an unfortunate occurrence that killed hundreds of people and prayed for the departed souls of our dear brothers and sisters who died during the mudslide to rest in peace.

He told the audience that because of environmental challenges facing the country, the government in its wisdom thought it fit to establish the Environment Protection Agency in 2008 as amended in 2010 charged with the responsibility to sustainably protect the environment.

He therefore encouraged all participants to be very attentive in order to participate and make meaningful contributions.

In his explanation, he highlighted the aims and mission of the organization and some of the unstainable environmental practices such as deforestation, mining (especially those mining close to the rivers), logging, charcoal production, slash and burn agriculture, bush fire, use of chemicals, Mangroves harvesting and backfilling of swamps to erect buildings in urban areas. These activities pose heinous environmental challenges and loss of lives and property worth millions of Leones.

He said women are vulnerable towards environmental challenges because they are caretakers of homes adding that climate change is not only real but it is under our feet.

He also talked on the consequences of bad environmental practices. These include loss of biodiversity, loss of revenue, land degradation, water contamination, erosion and flooding which have some adverse effects on the livelihood of the people because the community's socio-economic activities depend on this same environment.

He ended by calling on all and sundry to work with YoMSuD-SL so that environment can be sustainably managed for the betterment of Sierra Leone.

- ➤ Mr. Balla S.Kamara youth chairman thanked the YoMSuD-SL for the sensitization and urged the Organization to do more sensitization in remote communities as well as using the radio to pass on environmental messages.
